General Information

Phang-Nga is a province equally renowned for its beautiful land, spectacular bay, and amazing islands; Phang-Nga national parks feature magnificent scenery with immensely different attractions. Most famous is Phang-Nga Bay National Park, a geological wonder filled with islets, sunken caverns, and startling rock formations rising vertically out of the sea. The bay is extremely sheltered and therefore ideal for expeditions on sea kayak that explore the many fascinating caverns and islands throughout the bay.

Phang-Nga's Andaman coast offers equally stunning national parks of a different kind; the island groups of Surin and Similan are renowned for their beautiful, unspoiled beaches and spectacular underwater scenery, attracting divers from around the world. On the Phang-Nga mainland, Khao Lak features a coastal park full of rare birds, exotic mammals, and scenic waterfalls, as well as many luxury and budget hotels along the spectacular coast that was devastated by the 2004 Tsunami but has since been completely rebuilt





Panyee Island or Koh Panyee is a small unique village in Phang-Nga province in the South of Thailand. This wide-peaked limestone mountain provides good protection from the ocean waves and features a sizable sandbank which has become a settlement containing four small villages surrounded by resplendent nature, shady mangrove forests, and the numerous islands of Phang-Nga National Marine Park. Panyee Island is well-noticed as the first football field on the water in Thailand, and this field is ranked as the third most beautiful field in the world because of the spectacular view. This village is surrounded by shady mangrove forests and limestone mountains. Citizens on this island mostly are the fisherman, doing the hospitality, and producing their products of seafood such as shrimp paste, or an accessory made from pearl.




2. Phuket International Airport


Ocean Racing: For all type boats (OC1, SS1, SUP)

COR Day 1: Friday, 16 June 2023 (17 kilometers)



- 1. Starting from Harbor Phang-Nga Bay pier along the Panyee River to Panyee Island.
- 2. Going down south to Phang-Nga Bay make a u-turn at Lot cave in the Thalu Ok Island
- Turning bang to the football field at Panyee Island is the finish point for the first day of competition.

COR Day 2: Saturday, 17 June 2023 (20 kilometers)



- 1. Starting from the football field at Panyee Island along Khao Tok Nam canal to Lot Yai cave.
- 2. Going through Nai Ngob canal to Harbor Phang-Nga Bay pier is the finish for the second day of competition.

Canoe Marathon

CAM Day 3: Sunday, 18 June 2023 (Sprint 3.4 kilometers x 3)



- 1. K1 & C1 long distance race which starting from Harbor Phang-Nga Bay pier along Panyee River and along through Nai Ngob Canal to Harbor Phang-Nga Bay pier for finishing to Canoe Marathon competition.
- 2. Celebrating the Ocean Racing and Canoe Marathon Medal Ceremony at Le Erawon hotel.

The start and finish line and the portage (course detail will provide in Bulletin 2) All around the course the depth of the water will be at least 2 meters. 80 -100 meters portage is placed near the bank of the river near the finish line. Portage is according to the ICF rule.

Immigration during COVID-19

Since 1st October 2022 Thailand has lifted the requirement of the RT-PCR test before entry or proof of vaccination and fully re-opened to tourism. As a result, health insurance is not required.

We recommend travelers from China and India to study your respective country's rules of entry if the RT-PCR test is needed before travelling back. If yes, please inform the OC upon your arrival to arrange for the test. The hospital's charge for the test will be billed directly to you.

Insurances

All participants are strongly advised to have appropriate medical insurance policy from their respective countries.

ADEL Certification

For the ICF World Championships, ICF World Cups and ICF Ranking Races and Continental Championships, every athlete, coach, and support personnel must pass the relevant anti-doping online course on the Anti-Doping Education Learning platform (ADEL) corresponding to their role.

Athlete who has completed the online Anti-Doping education in the previous years is not required to complete again the course.
