SPECIAL ATTENTION!!

We have confirmed to race at the original race venue ie. Teluk Bahang dam, on the island of Penang. We would like to apologies for any inconvenience caused on the change of venue.

Some 80 teams from near and far will be participating in this regatta; they are from Australia, Brunei, Canada, China, Chinese Taipei, Dubai (UAE), Hong Kong-China, Indonesia, Japan, Macau-China, New Zealand, Philippines, Poland, Qatar, Singapore, South Korea, United Kingdom, USA, Vietnam and not forgetting many other states of Malaysia too.

Competition Regulation and Racing Rules

The Penang International Dragon Boat Regatta 2023 will comply with the PIDBF Competition Regulations.

Divisions, Racing & Competition Classes and Distances

The Competition Divisions, Racing and Competition Classes that will be contested are listed below:

Division

Premier – the primary class of racing. There are no restrictions on competitor's age. Open to all participants.

Senior 40 – Aged 40 years and above (born on or before year 1983); **except for the drummer.**

Junior Under 24 – Aged between 12 years and 23 years old (born on or between year 2000 and 2011; except for the steerer (helm).

Racing Class

Open – no restriction on participant composition (gender)

Women – for female participants only including the Drummer and Steerer

Mixed – 22 Racers: **minimum** of eight (8) and **maximum** of ten (10) paddlers of **either gender**. Drummer & steerer/helm can be any gender.

Mixed – 12 Racers: **minimum** of four (4) and **maximum** of five (5) paddlers of **either gender**. Drummer & steerer/helm can be any gender.

Race Format

- A) Straight course 400 meter
 - Teams may race through Rounds, Heats, Repechage, Semi Finals & Finals.
- B) Relay 400 meter
 - Each team must form **Two (2) 12 Racers boat** (Boat A & Boat B) to race over a 400 m course.
 - Boat A from each team will start at the Finish Line (in either Lane 2, 4 or 6) and race to the 400 m Start Line.
 - When Boat A reaches the Start Line, the drummer will pick the flag and throw it up high towards the sky; then Boat B (in either Lane 1, 3 or 5) will then race back to the Finish Line to complete the relay race.
 - Best time taken for Boat B at Finish Line will be determined as the winner.

C) Tug Of War

- Two teams will compete each time.
- Each team will be seated on the last 3 seats on either side of a boat, facing the opponent team.
- Teams will paddle to move the boat towards the opponent team.
- The team that manages to move the boat 1 meter in the direction from the center line will be determined as the winner.

Racing Style

Drummer and paddlers must be seated.

Race Schedule

2 December 2023 (Saturday) – 400m Relay & Tug of War (running simultaneously) *

*Special Advice - please do not assign the same player for these 2 events.

➤ 3 December 2023 (Sunday) – 400m Straight course

Prizes

Trophies and medals will be awarded to the winners.

Type of Boats Provided

Standard boat (22-seater boat) for all categories.

A competitor can only participate in one (1) team only.
