- 1. 20 Seater (Standard boat) a Dragon Boat boats consist of 26 crews is composed of:
  - Paddlers (minimum 18, maximum 20);
  - A drummer;
  - A steerer;
  - Four (4) substitute paddlers in the respective classes.
- 2. 10 Seater (Small boat) a Dragon Boat consist of 14 crews is composed of:
  - Paddlers (minimum eight (8), maximum 10);
  - A drummer;
  - A steerer;
  - Two (2) substitute paddlers in the respective classes.

# Entering to Thailand (from 1 May 2025)

1. All passengers must complete the Thailand Digital Arrival Card.

2. If the alien stays in the Kingdom longer than 90 days, he/she must notify in writing the nearest Immigration Officer, concerning place of stay, as soon as possible upon expiration of 90 days. And required to do so every 90 days.

3. Aliens are not allowed to work unless they are granted Work Permit.

4. Foreigners are required to submit their arrival card information 3 days in advance of their arrival date in Thailand.
