Please note that the official provisional schedule will be released when OC receive entries by number and events from MFs. OC may have rights to cancel the events which not enough entry or boats for participating in the Championships.

## 2.5 Entries

- The Preliminary Entry by number is due by **30 June 2025** and must include events to be entered, the total number of athletes in the team, and the number of officials and the number of accompanying teams.
- The Final Entry by name is due by **20 July 2025**, must include all necessary information of all participants, including the passport copies, the names and date of birth of each athlete, substitute and official.
- Entry Forms are attached to this Bulletin. These should be filled in and forwarded to the Organizing Committee, with a copy to ARF office, by the stipulated date.
- Entry fee may be collected from NF per event per boat.

**C1X = 100 USD, C2X and CMix2X = 120 USD**

Teams are strongly advised to consider carefully before making double entries. No changes to the timetables will be made to accommodate crews doubling up. No athlete should be entered in more than 2 events, athletes can only either for U19 (was born in 2007 and beyond) or Senior category, not allow the entries across the age groups.

## 2.6 Weather

The past average weather conditions in Jomtien Beach in August are as follows:

## 3. Boats and Equipment

- All boats and other equipment must comply with FISA Rules of Racing.
- All boats and other equipment will be provided by OC.
- All teams must use the standard pool of boats provided by the OC on a shared basis. Teams may not use their own boats.
- All boats will be set to a "Standard Rig" according to the rules of Beach Sprint. Only the foot stretchers may be adjusted by teams prior to racing.
- All boats and other equipment will be provided by OC and the official boat supplier, OC will provide all the boats and oars equipment.
- It is recommended that each team bring its own oars, and all blades of all oars/sculls must be painted on both sides in the colors of the respective federations. If you need to rent oars, the rate is 100 USD/pair of sculls for the duration of the event.
- All NFs must deposit the insurance fee for any boat damage happened, the fee is 300 USD per NF. This fee will be claimed back when the championships are finished.

### 3. Uniform

Each crew member shall display on their racing shirt or equivalent their three-letter member federation code and their family name (in Romanised text) centered on the torso of the rower with the family name above the federation code in the following manner and format:

### 4. Transportation:

Organizing Committee will arrange the round- trip from airport – official accommodation at 80 USD/person with shuttle van or bus. The local transportation from the hotel to the venue and also return during the event will be included in the official accommodation costing.

- Suvarnabhumi International Airport (BKK): 80 USD/person. The meeting point at Arrival floor at the Exit 4.
- Don Muang International Airport (DMK): 100 USD/person. The meeting point at: Arrival floor at Exit 5.
- U – Tapao International Airport (UTP): 40 USD/person. The meeting point at Arrival floor Exit 2.

### 5. Official Accommodation and Meals

D Varee Jomtien Beach, Pattaya and Bay Beach Resort will be the official accommodation. Bookings should be made through the Organizing Committee by 14 July 2025

The cost of accommodation includes accreditation fee, local transportation fee and half-board meals.

**Teams who do not enter the official accommodation, must pay the accreditation fee 30 USD per person.**

### Entering to Thailand (from 1 May 2025)

1. All passengers must complete the Thailand Digital Arrival Card.
2. If the alien stays in the Kingdom longer than 90 days, he/she must notify in writing the nearest Immigration Officer, concerning place of stay, as soon as possible upon expiration of 90 days. And required to do so every 90 days.
3. Aliens are not allowed to work unless they are granted Work Permit.
4. Foreigners are required to submit their arrival card information 3 days in advance of their arrival date in Thailand.
